Alpenrosen Folk Dancing News

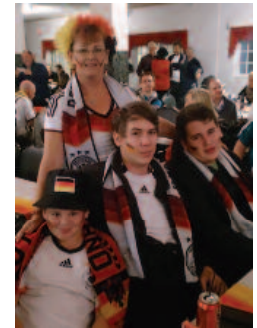
