

It's been an eventful two months since the last report. After the elections at the AGM on Sunday 24/09/2023 we have a partially new board. Welcome and congratulations to our new Treasurer Reimer Moeller and new Directors Michelle Hughes and Kathy Carseldine. Alex Hyde was reelected as Director while we sadly say goodbye to former Treasurer Paul Alldridge and former directors Eloise Sowden and Kurt Langer. It's been an absolute pleasure working with all of you. Special thanks go to Paul, as we worked very closely together over the past 2 years. We also said goodbye to our former GM Russell Finney, who resigned at the end of August due to personal reasons. The recruitment process for a new GM is under way and I am sure you will hear from them in the next issue of the newsletter.

On 8th of August the Brisbane German Club Restaurant opened and we welcomed many members and guests. It was a great effort from the new kitchen and service brigade around Chef Tory, Events and Service Manager Hugo and Restaurant Supervisor Maddy to get everything ready to open. The feedback we received in the first six weeks after opening was mostly positive and patrons enjoyed their meals. Leaking beer lines from our former keg cold room located behind the bar, prompted us to act. Our new keg room is significantly larger and allows us to hook up several kegs at the same time. This means our bar team won't have to change kegs during service anymore and it also smoothens the process of receiving deliveries. Our bottled beers are now stored in the former keg room behind the bar, freeing one of the other cold rooms to use for the kitchen.
